Argaum's April Double

With Torquay Athletic's first-class status the two clubs would have had few chances to meet at first team level but Argaum did play Torquay's second string, The Harlequins, regularly during the 1960s. In 1960-61 the two clubs met within the space of two weeks and the Plymouth club came out on top on both occasions. On 15th April at Bickleigh Down The Chiefs exploited some 'nonchalant' defence to run in 7 tries in a 25-0 victory. The return match,
